Firstly, may we offer you our sincere condolences.

How we move forward from here:

Your loved one will be transferred to our private premises.

We will contact you the next working day, usually in the afternoon between 2-3pm.

Any paperwork left by the certifying Nurse or Doctor along with your details will be sent by us to the deceased's GP.

The Medical Examiner

The deceased's GP will issue the Medical Certificate of Cause of Death (MCCD) to the Medical Examiner, who will scrutinise the paperwork.

He/She will contact you to discuss what will be recorded on the MCCD. At this point you will be able to raise any concerns you may have.

Once in agreement with you, the Medical Examiner will send the necessary paperwork to the Registrars for you to be able to register the death.

The Medical Examiner will also inform you of a date from when you will be able to register the death.

All funeral directors have been informed that funeral dates should not be put in place until you have made an appointment to register the death.
